Kids Club is an Omaha Public Schools Foundation program. While the program is held within OPS schools, your primary contact is OPSF. Any information updates or change in enrollment needs to be communicated to OPSF directly.

WALKING IN/OUT POLICY

For the safety and security of all children, parents/guardians are required to walk their child(ren) to and from Kids Club/ECE PreK every day!

Drop-offs and pick-ups at the curb, parking lot, or doorway are not permitted.

Parents/Guardians must personally walk their child(ren) into and out of the building. This ensures that staff can safely account for every child, provide proper supervision, and communicate important information directly with the parent/guardian.

Allowing children to enter or leave unattended creates safety risks and disrupts program procedures.

Not following these procedures could result in temporary or permanent loss of program privileges.

These expectations are in place to maintain a safe and secure environment for all families and staff!

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TITLE XX

It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to manage and maintain their child's Title XX authorization. Please ensure your authorization remains active and notify Kids Club of any changes to your eligibility or coverage.

If your Title XX authorization expires, is not renewed, or is terminated for any reason, your account will be billed at the standard Kids Club rate according to the normal billing cycle until a valid authorization is received.

MEDICAL

Please make sure any and all information regarding your child(ren)s health needs are updated in the Kids Club system, Daxko AND communicated to all staff at the site.

NOW HIRING

We're currently hiring caring, dependable staff to work with elementary students before and after school. Competitive pay and flexible schedules make Kids Club a great place to make a difference.

BILLING

All weekly fees are applied to accounts on Mondays and are due by Fridays of the same week. Auto pay accounts pull on Mondays.

If payment remains outstanding after two weeks, a \$25 non-payment fee will be applied to your account.

If your account is more than two weeks past due with no payment or communication, any child(ren) enrolled will not be allowed to attend until the balance is paid in full.

If non-payment fee has been applied and no payment has been made or if account has been charged 3 non-payment fees, registration WILL be cancelled at the discretion of the OPSF office and all future registrations must be approved.

If you are no longer in need of the program it is your responsibility to contact the OPSF office to cancel.



SNOW DAYS

Two (2) snow days have been built into the billing cycle. Families will receive a snow day discount at two designated times throughout the year that may not align with the snow days sanctioned by OPS.

* Built in snow days will not apply to Scholarship Sites, Title XX accounts.

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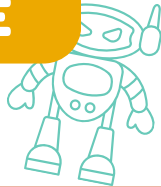
THINGS TO KNOW...

NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK



To help us keep all students safe, we ask that children do not bring outside food or drinks to Kids Club. We provide a daily afternoon snack, and students may bring a refillable water bottle if desired. This policy helps us manage food allergies, maintain a clean environment, and ensure consistency for all participants. Thank you for helping us keep Kids Club safe and enjoyable for everyone.

LEAVE TOYS AT HOME



We know students love sharing their favorite toys, but we ask that all toys, collectibles, trading cards, stuffed animals, and other personal items stay at home. Items brought from home can easily become lost, damaged, or cause distractions during program activities. Kids Club provides a variety of games, crafts, and activities to keep students engaged each day.

PERSONAL DEVICES



To encourage active participation, positive social interaction, and a distraction free environment, we ask that personal electronic devices, including cell phones, smart watches used for communication, tablets, and handheld gaming devices, remain at home or put away while students are at Kids Club. School issued tablets may be used only for homework or other school related activities. If a student needs to contact a parent or guardian, Kids Club staff are always available to assist.
